Program completion rate

Program completion rate is defined as the number of students who complete the clinical phase of the program within 150% of the stated program length.

This is based on the number of graduates actively seeking employment.

Not actively seeking employment is defined by JRCERT as:

- Graduate fails to communicate with program regarding employment after multiple attempts.
- Graduate unwilling to seek employment that requires relocation.
- Graduate unwilling to accept employment due to salary or hours.
- Graduate is continuing education.
- Graduate is on active military duty.
