Family Medicine Clinic – Rural Health

Mayo Family Medicine Clinic (Kasson, MN):

- Established by family medicine to meet a health provider shortage in Dodge County
- Serve the community of Olmsted and Dodge County
- Rural community with diverse and complex medical conditions
- Most patients prefer to receive care at Kasson versus traveling to Rochester
- Socioeconomic diversity; Spanish speaking patients
- Interprofessional team-based care
- Family medicine residents engage in patient home visits and community education in the local schools



Hospital Service

St Mary's Hospital/Methodist Hospital/Mayo Clinic (Rochester Campus):

- Diverse patient's from all over the world with a variety of common and uncommon diseases
- Pediatric Inpatient Service, Emergency Medicine, General Surgery services care for patients around the world and around the corner
- Family Medicine Inpatient Service, Obstetrics and Newborn Nursery predominately serves local residents in Olmsted and Dodge County

The Center Clinic: Building an Informed, Inclusive, and Healthy Community

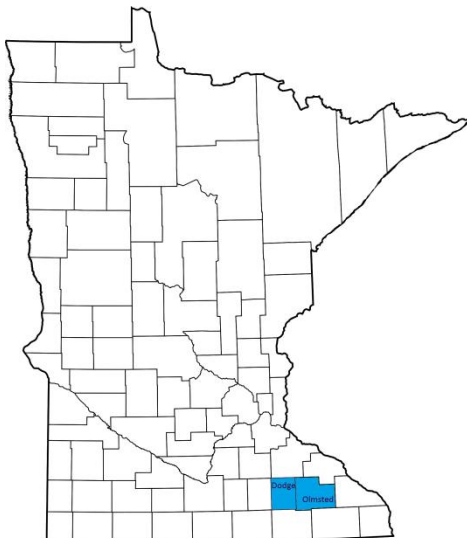


- Non-profit community-based organization in Dodge Center, MN (5 miles west of Kasson, MN)
